CLERK: Mr. President, I have received a communication from the University of Nebraska signed by William Swanson, Corporation Secretary, involving the University Health Care project on the University of Nebraska, Medical Center Campus. That communication will be forwarded on to the Reference Committee for possible referral to the appropriate Standing Committee for hearing. Mr. President, in addition to that, I have a letter of transmittal to Senator Labeledz as Chair of that committee.
