Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, whose Chair is Senator Baack, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature...to whom was referred LB 189, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File, signed by Senator Baack as Chair. Mr. President, Senator Wesely, as Chair of Health and Human Services, instructs me to report LB 51 to General File with committee amendments attached. (See page 350 of the Legislative Journal.)
