SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1 pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 374 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, 7 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 1 passes. LB 2.

CLERK: (Read LB 2 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 2 become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 375 of the Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 6 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 2 passes. LB 3.

CLERK: (Read LB 3 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 3 pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.
