CLERK:      26 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 142.

PRESIDENT: LB 142 advances. LB 156.

CLERK: Senator, the first item I have are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lindsay, please.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I would move that the E & R amendments to LB 156 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, in the interest of time, I'm not going to repeat what I said, other than to indicate, Senator Hefner, that what I said on the other bill goes double for this one.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is shall LB 156 be postponed? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lindsay, please.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that LB 156, as amended, be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please. Record vote has been asked for, requested.
