LB 184, 185

SENATOR LAMB: Is there any discussion of LB 184? If not, Senator Schmit, would you care to close?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be advanced.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion is the advancement of LB 184. Those in support vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR LAMB: LB 184 has been advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk, the next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 185 offered by Senator Schmit. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5, referred to Natural Resources, advanced to General File. Senator, I do have an amendment from you to add the emergency clause to the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: On the committee amendments, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, I would ask that the body adopt this amendment because the Game and Parks would wish that this change be implemented in time for use this year. The bill itself provides for an increase in the Cash Fund, which the Game and Parks can keep at their various installations around the state, from 1,000 to \$5,000. The increased traffic at the various parks necessitates this because it isn't too hard for them to get more than a \$1,000 in the fund at the present time. And since the Game and Parks decided that it would be helpful to them to have this additional management tool, I have agreed to offer the emergency clause so they would have it available to them for this year's operation. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Discussion on the committee amendment. Seeing none, those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendment to LB 185 vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.
