PRESIDENT: Thank you. Shall we move on to the resolution, LR 20, please. Excuse me, looking at the wrong day. How about number five, the confirmation report by Senator Withem.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Withem, as Chair of Education, would report favorably upon the appointment of Wynn Smithberger Nuckolls and Andrew Hove to the Board of Trustees of Nebraska State Colleges.

PRESIDENT: Senator Withem, please.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, the committee did hold a hearing on the appointments of Wynn Smithberger Nuckolls and Andrew C. Hove to the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges. We did inquire into their backgrounds and were favorably impressed with the two appointees, that they were going to be taking their responsibilities seriously. Just, parenthetically, yesterday I had an opportunity to visit with the Board of Trustees to witness the work of these two new appointees and I was very favorably impressed at that time also. I would encourage the body to vote favorably upon these nominations.
