SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that the E $\stackrel{.}{\alpha}$ R amendments to LB 459 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move LB 459 as amendment be advanced to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. That was the advancement, excuse me. It is advanced. Thank you. LB 458.

CLERK: Senator, I have E & R amendments on 458.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that the E & R amendments to LB 458 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nelson would move to amend the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dierks, are you going to handle that?

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President. Mr. President and members of the body, I visited with Senator Nelson and she asked that I withdraw this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection? If not, Senator Nelson's motion is adopted, amendment is withdrawn. Thank you. Anything else cn it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
