

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack, please.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. President, and members, this is another clarifying amendment in dealing with the application, and what this does is in the part that deals with the application, I think in the original bill, or in the committee amendments, it said that you would only send a copy of that application to the option district. This also requires that a copy of that application go to the resident district, so it just simply clarifies that that resident district will also be notified of the reasons that you have stated on your application for transfer. That is all it does. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Baack amendment to the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of AM0504.

PRESIDENT: The amendment to the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baack would move to amend, I have AM0506 in front of me, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack, please.

SENATOR BAACK: Mr. President and members, another amendment that clarifies the appeal process, and what it says is that, I think in the bill it says that they will follow the Procedures Act, the Procedures Act when they have an appeal to the State Board of Education, and this just adds the language, "and shall determine whether the procedures of Sections 1 to 14 of this act have been followed." It just clarifies what they are...what the appeal process is all about, that they are appealing on the basis of choice legislation. With that, I would just urge the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of AM0506. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of AM0506 as offered by Senator Baack.

PRESIDENT: The amendment to the amendment is adopted.
