American Rights Fund? And it is very possible that they are in this whole thing because in their figures show that they are only getting a 1,000 items back. His list say 11,000 items. Does that mean that he withheld the documentation on those? That is the only documentation they had to prove that, was the stuff that they had gotten from the Historical Society. To me it says, did they withhold that information from them? Are more items being able to be proved identifiable with the skeletal remains? I don't know. It leaves a whole lot of unanswered questions here.

PRESIDENT: Time.

SENATOR BAACK: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Labedz, followed by Senator Smith and Senator Warner.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I am a little sorry that Senator Chambers isn't on the floor because I certainly appreciate his statement on the bill itself. He, and I jotted down a few words that he used, he used human dignity and kept, at least two or three times, talked about the departed Catholics that want to be buried with their rosaries or other religious items, and I would like to say now that I do have sisters that their nineties. They already have given us a list of things that they want to be buried with including their rosaries and medals that they had blessed by the Pope and we certainly will honor their requests and bury the things that mean so much He also used the words that it's important precious to our religion, and they are important and precious to our religion and he mentioned also that what we're doing now is humiliating, degrading and demeaning. And I sat here thought about something that has bothered me consistently since I've been here in the Legislature, the fact that at our abortion clinics, and many of you have seen pictures of a garbage can filled with the remains of an aborted unborn child or you recall about three, four years ago there was a plumber was called out to an abortion clinic and in the garbage disposal that he, made him so sick he quit, he did not finish the job, they found crushed bones in the garbage disposal. Before I leave the Legislature I hope some day that I can introduce a bill, if the abortion is continued, to, in this country, to introduce a bill that requires an abortion clinic to bury the unborn child's remains after abortion is performed. That is something that you
