can't remember what the equation is, to be real honest with you, that they would get matching funds from the federal government to help complete that construction, because you understand as a member of the Appropriations Committee...

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute.

SENATOR HALL: ...that that money is nowhere near any amount necessary to provide for either those bus shelters, those buses or any of those other needs that the City of Omaha provides for visitors who come in and ride those various buses, stand in those bus shelters or whatever types of other services that are provided for them.

SENATOR MOORE: I understand that, Senator Hall, I just wanted to make sure that since there was one bill where you want to take money away from the City of Omaha and another bill where you want to give General Fund money to the City of Omaha, I just wanted to clarify the difference between the two bills.

SENATOR HALL: I want to help them take the money away as they have offered to let us do.

SENATOR MOORE: Okay, Okay,

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Haberman, please, Senator Moore on dack.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President and members of the body, I have three questions for Senator Hall.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hall, would you respond?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Hall, I will take them one at a time.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: The City of Omaha has funded approximately \$170,000 for the Lafern Williams Center, St. Vincent DePaul Society and the Salvation Army.

SENATOR HALL: Uh-huh.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Now would you suggest that the City of Omaha
