CLERK: Mr. President, 379, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 379 be advanced.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall LB 379 be advanced? All in favor Opposed no. Carried, the bill is advanced. LB 46, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, on LB 46 I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lindsay.

CLERK: Senator, on 145 I have £ & R amendments first of all.
