SENATOR LANDIS: There's been a request for a call of house, all those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The house is under call. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 1 may, Mr. President, to go under call.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. The house is under call, please return to your chair and check in. Senator Conway, your pleasure as to call in votes?

SENATOR CONWAY: I would initially take call ins, if people are coming in.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. The house is now under call, proceeding on the vote on the Conway amendment. Call in votes are permitted.

CLERK: Senator Rogers voting yes. Senator Moore voting yes. Senator Byars voting yes. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator McFarland voting yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Nelson, Senator Peterson, we need you to check in. Senator Ashford is here and is voting.

CLERK: Senator Ashford voting yes. Senator Nelson voting yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Conway's amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: The amendment is adopted. We'll proceed with the next order of business. Mr. Clerk, what is that order?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Conway would move to amend. Senator, I have amendment number 883 before me.

SENATOR LANDIS: Raise the call. Senator Conway, for his opening on the amendment found on Journal page 1147. Conway.
