CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that LB 285A as amended be advanced to E & R Final.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The question is the advancement of 285A as amended. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried. The bill is advanced. For the record, Mr. Clerk.
