SENATOR WITHEM: I think both with Senator Haberman's comments, Senator Wesely's questions and my introduction, there appear to be no other questions, so I'll just close by asking to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the question is, shall the bill be returned to Select File? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned to Select File. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes. The amendment that I'm asking you to adopt is an amendment to allow individuals currently who are currently school employees covered under the School Retirement System to be then employed by the State Department of Education to be given an election, within 30 days after employment in the department, of whether they wish to be covered by the State Employees Retirement System or continue to be covered by the School Retirement System.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Thank you, Senator Withem. The question is the adoption of the Withem amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The Withem amendment is adopted. Senator Withem, on the advancement.

SENATOR WITHEM: Senator Haberman's bill, but I'll just move to readvance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the question is the advancement of the bill to E & R Engrossing. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 410. Would you please return to your seats again, gentlemen. Mr. Clerk.
