Science or Master of Fine Arts. For 10 years they have been asking for these Masters programs. So what happens, students come to Kearney State, they want to take their Masters because they are teaching close or their husband has a job someplace so they come to Kearney. They must take their Masters in education and they do that. It isn't fair to the student but they know when they go into the school what they must do to get their Masters there. It is not fair to them but they do take the work that qualifies them for a Master education instead of their Master of Science or their Master of Fine Arts. There is nothing done in any way that does not come within their role and mission at all. This is no hurry, folks. Fifteen years is really not a big hurry. There are many people of vision in this state who feel that Kearney State belongs in the university's system. Of course, one of them is Woody Varner...

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute.

SENATOR LANGFORD: ...and he certainly is a man that we should treasure in this state for all of his time and effort that he has given to us in this state and he is an adopted son. Someone said that they had heard...I think it was Senator Wesely, from people all over the state that did not approve of Kearney coming into the university's system. I hate to remind him that Lincoln is not all over the state because we have graduates all over the State of Nebraska and we really hear from them because they are so delighted that there might be an opportunity for their alma mater to be in the university's system. Now why do we want this?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time has expired.

SENATOR LANGFORD: When a student goes to Kearney, they get a fine education. We really know they do because they're quite successful in their life's work.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time.

SENATOR LANGFORD: But...sorry. But they do not have their degree from a university and if they must seek work outside of the state...

SPEAKER BARRETT: I'm sorry, Senator Langford, time has expired.

SENATOR LANGFORD: ...then they would have a better opportunity
