SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Withem moves the previous question. Five hands? Yes, I do. Shall debate now cease? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Shall debate now cease? Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Chizek, would you care to close on your amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Very quickly, Mr. Speaker. So that you will know what the amendment of 747 into 84, 10 percent property tax rebate for agriculture and commercial property, homestead exemption in the amount of \$6,800 for residential property, a \$2,000 cap on the property tax rebate to any property owner, and I think that as I listen to my friend, Senator McFarland, I don't know as it could be much simpler. It's a flat 10 percent, \$6,800 on a residence with a \$2,000 cap. That is what this amendment does when it would be amended into Senator Lamb's LB 84 and now mine because I've signed on it. And I would ask the body's adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Chizek amendment to the committee amendments. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chizek and Moore's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. Next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is by Senator Lamb. Senator Lamb would move to amend the amendment just adopted. (Read Lamb amendment as found on page 1635 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. President, members. This is an amendment which was just handed up there. We do have another amendment to the amendment, Mr. Clerk, do we not, filed previously. Thirteen-fourteen.
