CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1711-12 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 4 nays, 1 present and not voting, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 395 passes. LB 47.

CLERK: (Read LB 47 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 47 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1712-13 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 47 passes. LB 66 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: (Read LB 66 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 66 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1713-14 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 66 passes with the emergency clause attached.
