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able to receive a proportionate share?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, Senator Smith, again, that is a question that can be resolved. At the present time, the language is so that we could resolve it.

SENATOR SMITH: Okay, all right, good, and then another question, and I want this for the record also then, and this is just a question I am now asking, what do we mean on page 17 in the top eight sentences right before you were going to insert your amendment where it says, "The money shall be distributed on the basis of the ratio of the total amount of taxes levied by each political subdivision to the total amount of property taxes levied by all such political..."

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute.

SENATOR SMITH: "...subdivisions on such property based on the amounts stated in the most recent certificate of taxes" and so on? Does this mean then like you would have a division then of the amount of money that they would receive in proportion to the amount that of the subdivision, such as school districts, NRD, community college, and those groups would...their share, their ratio?

SENATOR SCHMIT: That isn't our intent at this time, Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Okay, all right, thank you very much. I will support your amendment and I will oppose the Morrissey amendment. I am sorry, Senator Morrissey.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Morrissey, please.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Yeah, Mr. Speaker, I like Senator Landis's idea but at this time am going to withdraw the amendment and possibly I will talk to Senator Schmit, maybe offer it on Select. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, we are back to consideration of Senator Schmit's amendment, AM1417.
