PRESIDENT: Senator Smith, please.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. This is the A bill that would insert...that would strike the \$40,000 and insert the \$20,000 in line 2, and then again in line 3 strike \$75,000 and insert twenty...excuse me, million dollars, not thousands. Let me start over again here. All right, on page 2, line 2, strike \$40 million and insert \$20 million, and in line 3, strike \$75 million and insert \$20 million. I would ask for adoption of the amendment. Thank you.
