SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Korshoj, did you care to discuss the Warner amendment?

SENATOR KORSHOJ: Question.

SPEAKER BARRETT: I'm sorry, sir. Senator Withem, on the Warner amendment. Thank you. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Okay, we got it. Senator Warner, could you respond to a question, please, just a quick one. What I'm curious to know is have we covered the employee benefit packages and that sort of thing, like the retirement plans and that sort thing, or have you got it covered in your amendment, or covered somewhere else in the bill, so that if that gets transferred we're not dumping somebody's benefits.

SENATOR WARNER: All of those things are provided for in the original amendment, yes. The original amendment that was attached to LB 247.

SENATOR GOODRICH: That's all I need. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any other discussion on the Warner amendment? Seeing none, those in favor of its adoption vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the Warner amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Scofield would move to amend. Senator, I have your amendment AM1465. (See Scofield amendment on page 1806 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Scofield.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Mr. President and members, AM1465 is the amendment that Senator Withem indicated was coming. You have a copy that is lying somewhere on all this stuff that's been distributed to your desk. It's a fairly simple amendment. You will recall that the Withem amendment, which was adopted,
