CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner as Chair of the committee would move for the introduction of Req. 1251.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, as I indicated in the handout, Req. 1251 is the recommendation in the area of capital construction. I move its introduction.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? If not, the question is the introduction of the bill, the second bill introduced by Senator Warner. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the introduction of Req. 1251.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced. Mr. Clerk, the third bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner, as Chair of the Appropriations Committee, would move for the introduction of Req. 1250.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB(sic) 1250 is a bill that merely establishes a Cash Fund authorization within the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission. They do have some minor charges for material that people want copied there, and this allows them to make those collections and deposit them to the Cash Fund, and we also would be proposing some reduction in General Fund appropriations in an amount similar to what is expected to be available in the Cash Fund. As I recall, it is less than \$5,000, but they do need the statutory authorization for a Cash Fund in order to do that. So I'd move the bill's introduction.

PRESIDENT: The question is the introduction of the bill explained by Senator Warner. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the introduction of Req. 1250.
