things. So I am very serious about this amendment because think it focuses it in an area of greatest need, and certainly it does take away some of the local's freedom to make those decisions, but it does focus, and I think if you really want to do infrastructure and if you really want to call this bill an infrastructure bill, then that is what this amendment makes it. So I would ask you to adopt the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. And the question is the adoption of the Scofield amendment to LB 683. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? A record vote has been requested. Record, Mr. Clerk.

(Read record vote. See page 1880 of the Legislative Journal.) 14 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is not adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Conway.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Conway, please.

SENATOR CONWAY: I would like to withdraw that amendment, please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn.

Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit has indicated to me, Mr. President, that he wishes to withdraw.

SPEAKER BARRETT: So ordered.

Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Scofield, I am back to your AM1165, Senator. Copies have been distributed now I believe, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Scofield.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Thank you. Mr. President, I think because of the complexity of this and the outcome of the last vote, I don't think I will ask to take that amendment up today but I would ask that you print it in the Journal and people take a look at that.
