But I think we, as a body, I think it's wise if we sit here and say, we like LB 84, we like the price tag of LB 84, we like the cap in LB 84, we like the fact maybe it doesn't include personal property right now, we like the fact that it's just a straight homestead exemption because that's what we're used to. We like all those things. We're going to move this bill because from all we know now, the only thing we know now we have nothing official. We've got a lot of people that have questioned it. We have a lot of attorneys on the executive branch that say, we can't do it, in their opinion, but I'm not convinced of that yet. Let's adopt the Lamb, Chizek, Hall, Moore amendment...
