SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. President and members, I am going to talk about 15 different agencies and briefly explain their budgets. I'm going to list them for you now. Over the tech colleges, Postsecondary Coordinating Commission, State Treasurer, Department of Revenue, DAS, Economic Development, Accountability, Supreme Court, Department of Ag, State Board of Agriculture, Natural Resources, Corn Board, PSC, Military and Examiners of Land and Surveyors. I'm going to start on page 47 of the blue book with the Department of Administrative Services. As you can see we have General Fund appropriation for fiscal year '88...'89-'90 of 4.7 million. When you include the sizeable revolving fund in DAS, you're talking about a \$58 million total appropriation doing four basic things. To begin with one development of an on-line data entry system that will allow agencies to directly enter information to process warrants. Secondly, of course, the new Central Data Processing Print Shop across the street. There is some additional maintenance and security funds in for that. Thirdly, we've included some additional staff for Capitol maintenance for some specialized cleaning crews on some of the items in the Capitol with historic significance. You need specialized cleaning crews to operate on them. And fourth and finally, a rather sizeable amount, we're talking about developing a new program, the Nebraska Intergovernmental Data Communications Division which will begin a new program to administer a new statewide computer network that will link all counties, including such a variety of things that I'm sure we'll talk about later. Next agency, Political Accountability and Disclosure on page 46. Basically they are General Fund and General Fund appropriation of \$265,000; total funded \$275,000, very little change; \$20,000 for software development to put contribution reports on the state's mainframe computers. All of us involved in elections know what we're talking about there. Those reports will be on the state's mainframe computers now. And also because some Cash Fund authority, General Funds which are presently used to cover publication cost will now be reduced and they will use more Cash Funds. The third agency, Department of Agriculture found on page 104. General Fund appropriation, I'm going to use just your first year's to give you an idea, \$4 million in '89-90, 4,005,000 with a total appropriation of 10,098,000 for the year, a variety of things. First off, in administration we include money, continuation funding for the Farm Mediation Program. Also there is some increased General Fund support for the
