

center. And the Department of Tourism, \$150,000 in Cash Funds were added to expand promotional activities and to conduct a visitor's survey. Also there is \$50,000 in this area that...in relation to the activities of the Joslyn Castle in Omaha which Senator Ashford will probably at some point in time talk about. SAC Museum, additional funding to allow for a gift shop inventory expansion. And, of course, in state aid we have \$275,000 in each year of the biennium in the Industry Training Fund and the Research and Development Authority stays flat at \$2 million. Board of Examiners and Land Surveyors on page 76, there's basically no change. Military Department on page 78, we provide some additional funding for preventive maintenance of the armories, some additional retirement contributions for individuals reaching 25 years, not of age, but 25 years in service, I'm sure. Probably the one thing people are interested in, in the Tuition Credit Program an additional \$24,000 is provided each year to fund increasing tuition rates toward the trends of students taking more credit hours. Looking at Agency 55, Natural Resource Commission, as you can see there is an \$8.9 million General Fund appropriation for the '89-90 and 7.8 the next year. The major changes that we've done here, the one thing the committee did not include, \$500,000 that the Governor had recommended the Soil and Water Conservation Fund the second year, but we did increase appropriations to the Resource Development Fund. Now at present, the present funding level, that fund is \$700,000. The committee recommendation includes \$3.4 million for '89-90 and \$2 million in the next year. And if you want to look at page 114 of the book, the Natural Resource Commission, you will see primarily what the list of projects are that are being considered with the funding that the...the funding level the committee has recommended. You can list the projects and where they are found on page 114. Next on page 126, Nebraska Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education and basically the major change, there's been no...the committee recommended that no funding increase for the tuition assistance portion of this but they did recommend...we have recommended the student financial aid appropriation that does include a recommendation that the funds be separately accounted for in two separate budget programs for a variety of reasons I think we've discussed on the floor already. Last, but not least, my agency is found on page 81, the Public Service Commission. General Fund appropriation of \$2.2 million in '89-90 and basically \$2.2 million in '90-91 with a little bit of cash. That's about what the whole appropriation is for the Public Service Commission.
