

participate in this task force and work on this study. So this is basically just covering the expenses, out of the Cash Fund of the Insurance Department, of the work of the task force. I would be happy to answer questions, but I think it's a rather minor amendment. It will take care of a problem that they've had in anticipated costs that were greater than anticipated, and they need to meet that need or they will have trouble fulfilling the goals of that task force. So I would move for the adoption of this amendment, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir. Discussion? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this, just to indicate that, if we...If the Department of Insurance made a request for this, I do not recall that they did, because obviously we would have funded it had we known about it. So, with that I'd just recommend the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any other discussion? Seeing none, those in favor of the adoption of the Wesely amendment please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Bernard-Stevens and Wesely would now move to amend. This is the aquaculture specialist position at the University of Nebraska. (Bernard-Stevens and Wesely amendment appears on page 1942 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Bernard-Stevens, please.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This is an amendment that would add \$50,000 to the University of Nebraska, the Institute and Agriculture Department, and I think it was simply an oversight on the part of the Appropriations Committee. There were, basically, three bills or three areas that were not included in the mainline appropriations, and that would be a potato specialist, a poultry specialist, and an aquaculture specialist. The potato and poultry were put into the budget, but the aquaculture was inadvertently, I'm sure, left out, so this is an amendment that
