that... I will just give you a brief run down of where the money might go and what natural resource districts would qualify. The Nemaha, Papio, Missouri River, Lower Elkhorn and Lower Platte South NRDs probably would receive somewhere between 75 and \$100,000 each. The Upper Republican and Little Blue and the Lower Big Blue NRDs would probably receive somewhere between 40 and \$50,000 each, and the Middle Republican Tri-Basin South Platte and Lower Platte North would receive somewhere around 20 to \$25,000 each to put into soil and water conservation. This \$500,000, I might add, was recommended by the Governor, but because of other activity that the committee has already talked about, this funding was not included in the budget. So I would like to ask that the body consider putting this back in and I think it is advisable based upon the demand and need that's out there that we do what we can to meet the concerns that soil and water conservation really have out there in Nebraska. So I would move the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the amendment proposed by Senator Rod Johnson and others Those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Johnson.
