SENATOR HALL: Yes. Put it at the bottom of the pile.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next...Senator Schmit, the next amendment I have is from you, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I'm still gathering some information from the Research Office relative to that amendment. I respectfully request that it be placed at the bottom of the list also at this time. We're not ready for it at this time.

SPEAKER BARRETT: If there are no objections, so ordered.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senators Wesely, Morrissey, Smith and Coordsen.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, this is the same amendment I discussed earlier about the case management only, again, we're going to pass over it and work with the Appropriations Committee so I would withdraw it at this time.

SPEAKER BARRETT: So ordered. Withdrawn.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Withdraw.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the bill. (The Chambers amendment appears on page 2011 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I want to ask the Clerk a question. Mr. Clerk, is this the
