SENATOR HALL: Yes. Put it at the bottom of the pile.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn.

Mr. President, the next...Senator Schmit, the next amendment I have is from you, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I'm still gathering information from the Research Office relative to that amendment. respectfully request that it be placed at the bottom of the list also at this time. We're not ready for it at this time.

SPEAKER BARRETT: If there are no objections, so ordered.

The next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senators Wesely, Morrissey, Smith and Coordsen.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, this is the same amendment I discussed earlier about the case management only, again, we're going to pass over it and work with the Appropriations Committee so I would withdraw it at this time.
