SENATOR WARNER: Well, Mr. President, I just want to point out that what I said about the Game and Parks Commission could provide assistance, in their budget narrative, in their request for funding this year. What their budget narrative says is that they provided technical assistance to 26 fish, private fish culturalists which are growing, to put and take private growers and some six out of state. It's just to merely point out, including in their budget narrative in which they requested funds they have indicated they do provide this kind of assistance and that was the basis for my earlier remarks.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT: We will now reconsider. Senator Bernard-Stevens.
