

our constituents and our colleagues, why in the world are you spending all that money? And yet we come to the floor and the only criticism we get is, you ogres, why won't you spend money for this program and for that program? Senator Hall has, obviously, a good program, substance abuse. He's gone through the history of what has happened. We had some major increases in substance abuse. We have not decreased it. We increased it \$150,000 last year. We increased in \$500,000 two years ago. They're up to \$4.5 million right now. We're leaving that there. What else have we done? We have a trailer bill coming through that's going to be adding increased money to counties, increased money to cities. They have some responsibilities here. We fully funded in the Crime Commission, fully funded General Funds for the anti-drug abuse program that they put out grants for this very purpose, for apprehension and rehabilitation of substance and drug abuse. It's not like we haven't done anything. We have done a lot. But if you want to add another \$454,000, I've got some suggestions. Just in DPI alone, we can still pick up a \$100,000 for a radio talking book which is a very good program, but we didn't do all of that. We have got mental health, we should pick up another 555,000 that we didn't do. We've got the Emergency Psychological...Psychiatry Services for another \$300,000 that we didn't...we did 300,000, we didn't do it all. We got a million dollars that the Mental Retardation regions asked for that we didn't give. We gave them quite a bit but we didn't give them a million. They're still short a million. They would like to have that. Region 6 asked for \$527,000. We didn't give them all of that. We gave them some. And, of course, we have the Norfolk Regional Center. They want another \$500,000. In DPI alone, the requests that we had just of the things that we turned down that were formal requests, that's \$3.7 million. We increased their budget by a million and we turned down 3.7 million and that's one year. Next year it goes to 4 million. Next year it goes to 4.3 million just because of continuation budgets. Over four years, we're talking about some real money, I mean, it's \$15 million, it's not real money. And if you don't have enough ideas in DPI, let's talk about the Department of Education. My goodness, I've got 50 pages, 52 pages, excuse me, 52 pages in my book...
