SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I would like to have that amendment read so that it is in the record, and it will give Senator Lindsay a chance to locate it in his bill book.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The Chambers amendment would read as follows: To amend the Lindsay amendment, in line 3, after "knowingly", insert "and intentionally".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Lindsay, can I call your attention to a part of the existing language in the bill. Are you able to follow with me? Would you turn to page 2?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In subsection (1) you will see they are describing or defining what an abortion shall mean. A person would have to, and it is not just a device or a procedure but something that can be administered, so it could be a fluid or anything taken by mouth, but we see in line 5 that it must be administered with the intent and result of producing an abortion. So since there are substances that could qualify as the abortion activity, a person could knowingly administer this, and I think they might even have enough knowledge that it might produce an abortion, but there are substances that can be taken for purposes other than abortion but they will have the effect of that. So the person should not only knowingly but intentionally cause or perform the abortion and I don't see that that would be out of keeping with what your purpose is. We are not trying to create a trap by the amendment that you are offering and I am not trying to create a trap by the language that I am offering. It would make it consistent with the language in the bill that there is knowledge and there is an intent, and especially should this be the case when there are things that could cause an abortion when that is not the intent that the person has for administering it. If it is a procedure, we know, but the definition of abortion includes more than just a procedure. So, members of the Legislature, I forgot it is my time, I am offering this amendment to Senator Lindsay's
