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during the debate. But please, please allow us to reconsider this matter. I will give a minute of my time to Senator Hefner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner, please.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I rise to support this motion. I think the amendment that we adopted yesterday is a little unfair because the original proposal would put the four offices across the state. Now we have this amendment that just goes through the center of Nebraska. Like I told you yesterday, I feel that all parts of the state, the people of all parts of the state should be able to go to an office, an economic development office that is in fair driving distance. And I feel by having just the three offices, in Ainsworth, Ord and Red Cloud, well we are depriving some of the people of other parts of the state, an unrealistic driving distance. I feel that the first proposal that we have was a fair one and I would urge you to vote for this reconsideration motion.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Back to you, Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, Mr. President. I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 6 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please return to your desks and record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Let's return to our seats and record our presence so we can find out who is here and who isn't, we'd appreciate that so we can move on. Shall I call your names? Senator Weihsing, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. We're looking for Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Landis, would you check in, please. Thank you. We are all here, with the exception of those who are excused. And the question is the reconsideration of the Scofield amendment to the Bernard-Stevens amendment. All those in favor of reconsideration vote aye, opposed nay. Did you ask for a roll call vote, Senator Byars? Okay. Roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.
