PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR WESELY: ...really the way to go. I appreciate Senator Conway and Senator Smith and Senator Korshoj and Senator Scofield and the other individuals who have supported this. Let's adopt this amendment, let's move forward in this fashion and you'll, I think, reach a compromise that will reach out to rural Nebraska in a way that doesn't duplicate and waste money and is actually going to do something that will help our rural small businesses. I move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: (Mike off.) ...call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed... Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 1 may to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Please look up to see if your light is illuminated. We're looking for Senator Conway. Senator Weihing, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. Senator Lamb, Senator Hefner. Senator Ashford. Senator Peterson, please. Thank you. Senator Ashford, Senator Chambers. Senator Rod Johnson, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. Senator Haberman and Senator Chambers and Senator Ashford.

SENATOR WESELY: That's okay, you can go ahead and start on a roll call. That's be...

PRESIDENT: Okay, a roll call vote has been requested and the question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See pages 2114-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.
