In many cases that person is going to be much more effective, much more able to better perform the jobs that he is going out there to do, not working under the NBDC but simply having those locations identified so that we know that that person has the synergy that is going to come by operating where we already have these kinds of resources there. We also are going to have a lot of that, a much better communication flow because in many cases as we work on with business development centers, we end up picking up the phone and spend many days back and forth communicating with the same person who is going to be sitting across the desk or at least maybe in the next office next to you on these sites. So I think without question we can parlay this into a situation to make it even better; we accomplish the executive branch's decision, their desire to put some professional face that one can recognize out in the local communities. That person will have his own schedule doing whatever it is DED wants him to do, but when he is in the office he has access to the resources that are there and maybe more importantly, the NBDC centers now have access to a face that they can call their own out at DED that's also right there and I think without question this would provide much better synergy, accomplish the task and if we're going to put them out in the field, we ought to put them in the right places and I think this is the best place to put them.
