PRESIDENT: Senators, please take your seats so the Clerk can hear your response. It is distracting.

CLERK: (Continued reading roll call vote. See pages 2115-16 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 20 mays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment fails. Do you have anything else on it, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised.

Mr. President, I have nothing further to the Bernard-Stevens, Schellpeper amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now we're on the Bernard-Stevens amendment. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Are there any other lights at this point?
