Senator Lamb. Senator Chambers, Senator Ashford. Senator Weihing, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. Senator Rod Johnson, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. We're looking for Senator Chambers. I understand Senator Chambers is on his way, and the question is the adoption of Senator Conway's amendment and a roll call vote has been requested. CLERK: (Continued reading roll call vote. See pages 2115-16 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment fails. Do you have anything else on it, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further to the Bernard-Stevens, Schellpeper amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now we're on the Bernard-Stevens amendment. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Are there any other lights at this point?

PRESIDENT: Yes, there are four.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay. I think I'll, at this point, just give my time now to Senator Schellpeper.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schellpeper, please.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. President and members, I think we have debated this issue long enough this morning. The bill may not, or the amendment may not be in the perfect form, but I think it's in a form now that it should probably move forward. I think if there's anything that needs to be done we can do it on Select File, so I would just move, or suggest right now that we just move this amendment forward. Thank you.
