PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner, you have half a minute.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, thank you, Dave. I just want to point out to this body that we do have field offices from other departments, like the Department of Revenue, the Department of Social Services, the Highway Department. We do have field offices and so I don't see what's so bad about having field offices for the Department of Economic Development. They worked good before and I think they would work good now. So I would urge you to support this amendment.
