can't proceed with what I have. My understanding that the amendment would...that with this amendment the way it is offered would have the cost of about 70 million so that would be coming very close to reimbursement without interest, but one would still have to adjust, because I have no intention to jeopardize the balance that those who have put the bill together feel they have between different classes of property.

SENATOR NELSON: Personally, I have a little problem since we have made one payment to Commonwealth to come back in and include them with the same, but I'm not to say it at this point but I truly want the body to know that I also have a great concern for this group of people. Senator Lamb, you want..oh, do you want the remaining part of my time? I thought maybe Senator Chizek was kidding me.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. President. I forgot to mention when I was speaking before that I had a suggestion for Senator Warner that if there is some additional money needed for Commonwealth or whatever else, maybe we could take it out of capital construction which is considerably higher than the Governor has recommended and that that might be a more appropriate place to look for additional funds, if that would be acceptable.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Warner, this is your time, yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Thank you for that suggestion, Senator Lamb. If you will perhaps notice, if you would look at the tape that when I initially started I made it a, I thought, I hoped I had made it very clear that the thought had been in my mind from the beginning of the session that should there be "surplus funds" not needed for state operations or the basic aid programs that we have in place, that then I felt the first responsibility of some funds and these have to be considered surplus funds because there is no intent to do it more than one time. one-time money and to use one-time money then for a purpose that will be discontinued, obviously the reimbursement of those citizens that lost funds would be an appropriate way. But as I indicated, thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, for extending some time. It was a serious amendment and I obviously should have had it drafted precise and I did not, but I will offer it so that it will be correct and maintain that balance and with that I'd ask unanimous consent that the
