

SPEAKER BARRETT: Or would you prefer to lump...

SPEAKER BARRETT: I believe that we are referring to sections in the bill, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: So if the amendment, like item 3 of the amendments, it says, strike original Sections 18, 19, 20, and 21.

SPEAKER BARRETT: We would be discussing...

SENATOR WARNER: That would be four separate items, wouldn't it?

SPEAKER BARRETT: That is correct. That is absolutely correct. Any other questions? Senator Hall would you like to proceed or, excuse me, Senator Dierks.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hannibal, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: A point of clarification. When an amendment is divided, the person asking for a division, is it, would it their prerogative to speak first on each individual section or how will that be handled?
