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go through them quickly. If you prefer not to speak, please say so.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Well, Mr. Speaker, I will speak for a moment. I do support the project, as I do all the projects in the budget. I would ask a couple of questions, if I may, of Senator Korshoj and Senator Hartnett. I didn't hear the answer that they gave to Senator Scofield completely. We have an amendment now that we are going to take something out that I don't believe either one of you are supporting. Are you supporting taking this particular project out of the books, Senator Hartnett?

SENATOR HARTNETT: I am still debating it. You know, I think that Senator Korshoj said that he wants to put it back into the budget.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Um-huh.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I am still up in the air.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Okay. Senator Korshoj has said that he didn't want to take it out. I guess my question I have then is, why have we addressed an amendment, why have you brought an amendment to us to take it out if you are not sure whether you want to take it out, in the one case, and the other case saying I don't want to take it out? Why did we not leave that off the list, I guess? This is my time, Senator Lynch, and I will be happy to ask you that question.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I think I maybe expressed that, Senator Hannibal, at first is that I simply want to know, you know, what you put in. You know, you put some things in above the Governor's budget and that's what we are discussing, this is one of the items that you put in, and is there good rationale for it, and I think you said that you support it. I think Senator Korshoj supports leaving it in, and so forth. I will.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Before Senator Lynch busts a gasket here, I'd like to ask him the same question, so he can answer.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lynch, would you respond?

SENATOR LYNCH: Oh, it is not difficult to answer at all. Senator Hartnett and Senator Korshoj offered an amendment which at this point in time was not adopted, so they can't answer that
