So the 30 times 50, the million, five, the other 500,000 will be spent on...don't look frustrated at me, Bernice. I'm just curious about how it's going to be spent. So it will be 500,000 of the 2 million spent on gardens or ski trails or what?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Anything that is necessary to complete the park so that it will not delay opening. If we don't get some state funds, it will be at least two years before the park can be opened.
