

to monitor all of that. You can't just do that because you want to. It does have to have a plan and it has to have people. You have to have equipment, that is 24 hour a day monitoring. You can't do that with just a couple of people. So until we come up with some kind of plan like that, I guess we are still going to have to have the jails. I have one other question of Senator Hannibal, just another quick one. When we talked about the one in Omaha, someone mentioned, I think maybe you did, that there was a possibility of contracting with like county jails to take on prisoners if they needed it, was that right? Did somebody...but wouldn't you have a problem, maybe all the county jails might not be up to federal standards, right? I mean you can't just take them out to like Mayberry RFD, right?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: That is true.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay, because here in Lincoln, in Lancaster County, they have gone on for years, massive negotiations and hearings trying to get a new jail site. They argued and argued about where they were going to put it. That is not easy, so that would be a factor, actually, as to whether the jail they were going to contract with was up to standards.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Certainly that would be a factor, although the county jails do fall under the same jail standards act, I think, as do the State Penitentiary.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay, I did vote...I voted in the affirmative on the last two amendments. The one thing that concerned me about the disciplinary area at the penitentiary is the safety feature. I would hate to be in there and think that somebody, if there was a fire, that maybe somebody would have to come in with some kind of blowtorch and get me out because a mechanical thing wasn't working. So, well, I guess what I am coming down to is that I would hope the study, and you seem to be the one who oversees this part of the budget, Senator Hannibal, I would hope that the study maybe would go back and look at all of those things again because this is a never-ending subject, just like I guess everything else. You never get to the point where it is perfect, so I would hope that everything would be looked at again, and I am pleased to see that you did bring in new buildings for industries and so on, which I think that enters into some of the rehab part and so on. But in the study, the other thing, I think Senator Hall or Senator Moore maybe came up with this,...
