

going to address that problem to the tune of about \$6.5 million. There is \$3 million in there. This \$3 million here is where we need to wait and make sure that that is the right thing to do, and if you don't do this, then, basically, what you have done is you have, basically, said go ahead, because there is no doubt in my mind if you don't take it out now, the study, like Senator Chambers is absolutely correct, the study is going to come back and say do it and probably with little to no fanfare next year, we are going to appropriate the \$3.1 million to build it. And so I think unless you take it out now, you, basically, have said go ahead and build the whole shooting match, and I guess I think it is wise to...my concern was originally we did not put this program in, and we decided after, a little bit later, after we put the study money...study language in, we would go ahead and do it, I think it is wise to look at it one more time and say let's study it. Then next year if the study says, yes, let's do it, then at that point in time, you are absolutely right, Senator Warner, we start from scratch and see if there is \$3 million next year to fund this proposal. I urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Moore amendment to the amendment to strike Section 21. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? This is an amendment to the amendment on General File. Are you sure? Oh, I am sorry. It is appropriations. My mistake, I beg your pardon. Have you all voted? Senator Chambers, did you request a call? Shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, to go under call.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Members, please record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return. Senators Lindsay, Wehrbein and Goodrich. Thank you. May we proceed? Thank you. A roll call has been requested. Please return to your seats. The question, again, is the Moore amendment to the amendment. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.
