SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is from Senator Hartnett and Korshoj by moving to strike original Section 29, Senator.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, I would move that we adjourn for the evening and then come in at eight o'clock tomorrow morning.

SPEAKER BARRETT: For the record? You have heard the motion to adjourn until tomorrow morning at eight o'clock. Those in favor vote aye, excuse me, those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The ayes have it. Motion carried. We are adjourned. (Gavel.)
