PRESIDENT: Your point is made. Senator Moore, please.

SENATOR MOORE: I move the bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: Yes, that's right. Okay. Senator Moore, did you wish to speak on it, on the advancement of it? All right, Senator Withem, please.
