PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill. Machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2189-90 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the readvancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is readvanced. So we can read the bill now. Would you please take your seats and the Clerk will read the bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 812 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 812 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please. We are under...we are on Final Reading. Shall we have a check-in, please, so we make sure we're all here. Please record your presence. Thirty-three votes are required on this. Please record your presence. Senator Conway, please. Thank you. They are all recorded that are here. Now roll call vote on the advancement of the bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See pages 2190-91 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill fails to advance. The bill fails to pass with the emergency clause, I should say. Okay, now we vote on it without the emergency clause. Mr. Clerk. Okay. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 812 pass without the emergency clause? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have a motion, excuse me.
