Arguments have been made that for less than half of what has been proposed the building can be put in total repair but yet folks don't want to look at that. They want to run and rush into the argument and cry wolf. Well, I would urge the body not to do that. The reconsideration motion totally acceptable but I would urge you not to change your vote on the E clause with regard to LB 812. The other programs can be taken care of. I mean, it is...if Senator Warner's argument is the case, then I would hope that the kill motion would come up on LB 812 if the reconsideration is not done or the E clause is not passed.

SENATOR ABOUD: Question.

PRESIDENT: The question has been...thank you, but it won't be necessary, but, thank you anyway. Senator Hannibal, would you like to close on your motion to reconsider, please.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. President and members, as Senator Warner pointed out, I'm sorry that I did not, that the deficit appropriations bill is a bill that has to take place within the current fiscal year. And the current fiscal year will be over June 30th. This bill, if it passes but without the emergency clause, will not take effect until after that date which means you have no bill whatsoever. In my fervor on whether it would affect pharmacy or not, actually, it probably wouldn't affect pharmacy if it were an appropriation that just they wouldn't get for 90 days. But the fact is they will get no appropriation, not even 90 days because the fiscal year will be over because the appropriation is for fiscal year right now. All these issues in this bill are for fiscal year right now. As Senator Hall pointed out to you, if you don't pass it with the E clause, you might as well kill it because it's the same effect. Now I realize that it's very popular to bash on the Appropriations Committee and, believe me, I feel duly bashed the last couple of weeks, and if you were...if that was your goal, it's worked. However, I don't think that you need to carry your frustrations of the committee, of the process, of the lack of knowledge on all the things that go in the budgets, I don't believe you need
