in the first year, give us enough money to do the planning phase, and the second item of funds in the second year of the biennium would take us up through design development, up to the blueprint stage. But then the Legislature would still have to reaffirm its wish to consider and to continue with that project.

SENATOR KORSHOJ: So where does this money show up in our budget, 3,680,000? Where does it show up on, for instance, our green sheet?

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Well, take a look back here on...under LB 814, then take a look back here under, take a look at yesterday's where I noticed it, marked it. Under LB 814, if you look in the bill specifically, if you look at the language of the bill, Senator Korshoj, that is where that would show up, is within the actual text of the bill. And it is laid out according to how much would be expended each year. But obviously there is room for the reaffirmation. But within LB 814, on the green sheet here, the assumptions based on 814 is where you'll find that under capital construction. I don't know if I've got...have I gotten at what you want?

SENATOR KORSHOJ: Well, this money, we're committing ourselves to it? Is it coming out of the reserve now? What the...

SENATOR SCOFIELD: You are...if you vote for this issue this year, you are saying, yes, go ahead and do the planning, up through the design development stage. Obviously, it would take a second motion by this Legislature to reaffirm that intention, and there is room created at the bill for the second motion. But, obviously, we don't commit future Legislatures to expenditures.

SENATOR KORSHOJ: That was my question. You want the rest of my time or not, just roll on, go on.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Thank you, Senator Korshoj. I was going to make those points in my remarks. And I appreciate your raising those, and I'll reiterate. Ninety-eight thousand the first year, for the Trailside project, is the planning phase. There has been a needs assessment, a needs statement, which is the first step of any capital construction program, essentially accomplished through the actions of citizen and volunteer work. That's the first phase. That one is done and I believe is acceptable to the state building process. So this \$98,000 would
