I thought it was very minimal for the amount of money that it's done, the 18.2 million, or so on. I guess what I'm saying is I think it's time that we be a little bit cautious on our spending and look outside and look down the road and be doggone sure that this money is going to be here in the next few years that we are committing here today. And, with that, I'm not...I'm going to support Senator Hartnett on this amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. There are no other lights on. Senator Hartnett. Thank you. Senator Hartnett waives. Ready for the vote which, again, an affirmative vote is to delete, a negative vote is to leave as is. Those in favor of the motion please vote aye, opposed nay. Record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I would like to have a call of the house and a roll call vote so there will be a record on this issue.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return and record your presence. Senator Robak, please. Senator Pirsch. Senators McFarland, Lamb, Beyer, Wesely, the house is under call. Senator McFarland, Senator Beyer, the house is under call. Senator Moore, may we proceed? Members, return to your seats for a roll call vote.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Before we go, would you explain the vote again before we vote?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Yes, thank you, Senator Ashford. The motion is to delete Section 39, as I recall, and a vote in the affirmative, a yes vote is to delete; a no vote is to remain as is, status quo. Mr. Clerk, proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See page 2241 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion fails. The call is raised.
